Footnotes

CANE CANDY settled back two deep, bid off the rail from the three eighths pole, progressed through the turn, dueled for control inside the eighth pole and edged away toward the wire. CHAMP DIMARE stalked the pace off the rail, took aim leaving the three eighths pole, was carried out entering the stretch, dug in to best the pacesetter at the sixteenth pole and finished evenly in place. COLLECT THE FEE pulled herself to the lead, rated the pace to the quarter pole, was pressured while losing ground into the lane then leveled off the final furlong. ELECTRICA, unhurried inside, bid off the rail midway on the turn then leveled off in the lane. SHE'S A PISTOL saved ground just off the pace but had no response on the turn. ALLY'S TOM CAT showed no speed outside, had no response while losing ground at the quarter pole then weakened in the stretch. VIRGINIA DREAM rated close about the three path, gave chase through the turn then weakened into the stretch.
