GREEN GLORY, unhurried inside, started improving her position through the turn, eased out entering the stretch, surged to the front a furlong away and drew off the final sixteenth. NORWAY STAR settled off the early pace inside, came under pressure from the three eighths pole, raced in close contention through the upper stretch, was no match for the winner though proved second best. FULL MOON FROLIC rated the pace off the rail, lost ground leaving the turn then weakened in an outward drift. CAT WIESEL rated back about the three path, picked up the chase toward the turn and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. QUEEN OF CHIC stalked the pace from the inside, gave chase at the rail through the turn and remained a close factor to midstretch before weakening. QUEEN CLEOPATRA chased the pace from the outside, came through the turn about the six path and weakened in the stretch. ELUSIVE CHAMPAGNE chased the pace off the rail, drifted outward on the turn, entered the stretch five wide and weakened from there.
