COOL CARA moved up three wide on the turn to challenge for the lead then pulled away in the final furlong under a drive. AGELIKA, outrun early, responded well outside rivals in the drive to gain second. SPECIAL RED prompted the pace two wide and weakened in the final furlong. INCASE SHEBETS lacked a solid closing response. HIGHER GEAR was outrun. HOPETOWN broke alertly to show the way to upper stretch and tired. STACYS TOY prompted the early pace along the inside and tired. SPELLING BOOK was through early.
