TO THE CROWD moved up around rivals on the turn, dueled in the final furlong and finished on even terms with DEVIL'S HONEY. TIPPING LIGHTLY was rated close to the pace, moved closer in upper stretch then was no match for the top two and held third. JOURNAL TIME was boxed in along the inside on the turn then finished best of the others. MADAM KIPPER vied for the early lead and weakened. JEWEL ALARM prompted the early pace outside rivals and weakened. MINUTES AHEAD lacked a rally. PICCOLO HONEY was outrun.
