### Footnotes

GRISHAM unhurried early, was boxed through the second turn, swung out five wide to secure clear racing room out of the turn then wore down LAST PUFF in the late stages under strong handling. LAST PUFF stalked the leaders for six furlongs, got through along the rail out of the second turn to gain a clear lead but couldn't turn back the winner while clearly second best. SILENT ACADEMY chased the leader early, bid after three furlongs, remained prominent to upper stretch then weakened. YANKEE CROSSING set the pace inside to the stretch before giving way. TARPLAN raced evenly. SWEET BLISS stalked the leaders for six furlongs then faded. STREAKING ROSE popped his starting gate doors an instant before the start and as a result, was on his hind legs at the break.
