PLAY BINGO was well placed racing close up along the inside, hit the rail and bobbled in upper stretch then continued gamely to prevail for second. DINNER IN ODEM was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to just miss for second. TAP DAY was well placed racing close to the pace then faded in the drive. QUITE ACCEPTABLE raced within striking distance outside rivals then weakened in the drive. UNION AVENUE stalked the pace then had little left for the drive. MABOU raced under steady restraint much of the first half mile then had no response.
