ANNIKA LASS moved up along the inside into the stretch and closed determinedly to get up in time. FORTRESS HILL dueled for the lead two abreast and held on stubbornly to the end. STORM MINSTREL chased the leaders, loomed boldly in midstretch but was not good enough. BALDOMERA was outrun early then finished willingly from the outside to close the gap. UMPATEEDLE broke sharp, saved ground disputing the pace and gave way grudgingly. FINANCIAL RISK showed speed from the outset and lacked a solid stretch response. FANTASTICA ROMA (ARG) prompted the early pace then weakened in the drive. HIGHER GROUND showed little. CLOUD SURFER was outrun.
