PEAK MARIA'S WAY prompted the pace then edged to the front with a two wide bid on the far turn then edged away under steady handling. BONDAGE was put to a drive on the far turn in pursuit of the leader then lacked the needed stretch response and finished second best. LADINA, well placed racing close to the pace, faded in the drive and was easily third. DURAJAZZ lacked a rally. CIRCUIT BREAKER saved ground setting the early pace and weakened. MISSILE WARNING hopped at the start to be away slowly then was outrun. PICK UP THE TEMPO tired.
