DANCE THE SLEW, away alertly and well handled setting the pace off the inside rail, was ridden out. MAJOR GAMS, unhurried early, rallied leaving the far turn and finished second best. PICKET moved up between rivals on the far turn then lacked a further response. PAPIER MACHE advanced along the inside on the far turn then flattened out. HEAD MAJORETTE showed little. CRAFTY ATLANTIC tired. STORMY SEA prompted the pace through the backstretch and tired.
