Supplemental nominations of \$1,200 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 at a mile or over in 2000 allowed 3 lbs. Two races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Such a race 9 lbs. Starters to pass the entry box by the usual time of closing. Field limited to 12 starters. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings. Trophy to the winner. Closed Wednesday, May 17, 2000 with 35 nominations. (Chapel supplemented at a cost of \$1,200).

Footnotes

SENZA PAURA stalked the pace for five furlongs, split horses on the second turn to move to the lead, drew off to mid stretch then proved clearly best under steady handling. CHAPEL made an inside middle move then couldn't gain on the winner in the drive while racing a bit erratic through the final furlong. CRYSTAL SEA dueled inside after bearing out a bit at the start, ducked in on the backstretch then weakened leaving the second turn. SIMPLY RUNAWAY was well placed but failed to respond. JERA dueled to the second turn then weakened. ZENITH failed to menace. MY SPECIAL K'S showed little. WEEKEND KAPER was no factor.
