BELONGS TO DIXIE was away in good order then finished well to gain third late along the inside. BOOTH BAY was forwardly placed outside rivals then faded in the drive. CLEAR CONCEPT prompted the pace from the outset then faded in the drive. LOOKS LIKE SIS was checked along the inside on the first turn then again on the far turn. NORTH LIGHT LADY failed to threaten. COUNTESS JOHANNA lacked a rally. POTNIA'S SONG showed little. MIDNIGHT EXCHANGE was outrun. BESSIE

DAHLHAMMER ducked out at the start then was crowded and checked. MIGHTY MO C saved ground setting the pace then tired.
