KAFWAIN WEDGEHEART chased the winner throughout, was no match for that one but bested the rest. CHANCE AND A HALF made a middle move then flattened out. WORTHY WAGER weakened gradually. VEER failed to menace. CHANGING FUNDS showed little. BOUNDINGOUTTHEGATE was through early.
