ROSES FOR RUBY, never far back, moved closer outside rivals into the far turn, drew clear in upper stretch and held sway under strong handling. CLICK ON ME made a run leaving the far turn then closed under a hard drive. MAGIC PEAK unhurried early, rallied into contention into the stretch and closed well. RESTRAINING ORDER stalked the pace and flattened out in the drive. FANTASY JET failed to threaten. OUTDONE prompted the pace two abreast and weakened in the drive. RED AND WHITE failed to menace. DIZZY saved ground setting the pace for six furlongs then had little left. ONLY ON BROADWAY attended the pace to the far turn and tired. TIGHTASAMOUSESEAR tired. Portable inner rail set out 15 feet.
