ALMA D'ORO chased the leader from the outset, got through along the rail to challenge into the furlong grounds then continued gamely through a long drive to just miss. SECRET GETAWAY closed a gap behind the leaders but too late. HARLEM ROCKER was well placed throughout then was slowly gaining late outside. GOLDSVILLE was also well placed to late then gave way.
