SILLIUM was unhurried early, was boxed along the inside rail on the far turn then closed along the inside rail through the stretch and got up in the late yards. DR. SKIP was unhurried early then finished fast between rivals to get up for second. CORE OF STEAL was unhurried early then closed determinedly outside rivals in the stretch. CHACO CANYON broke sharp to dispute the pace along the inside then gave way grudgingly. DUFFY JUNIOR contested the pace racing two abreast and gave way grudgingly. AVENGING was well placed close to the pace but lacked the needed closing kick. CHOPTANK raced within striking distance but lacked the needed closing response. KUGGERAND was forwardly placed then faded in the drive. SNEAKY LOUIS lacked a solid rally. GHOST TRACKER was forwardly placed to the stretch then weakened in the drive. YESTERDAY'S ISLAND prompted the pace for six furlongs then tired. BRADENBROOKE tired.
