LADY RAVEN stalked the pace inside, got through along the rail leaving the second turn to open a clear lead a furlong out then had enough left to hold sway late. BUTTERDISH made an inside middle move, angled out four wide out of the second turn then was slowly gaining late while second best. WHO PLAYS BRAHMS lodged a mild belated rally. CALLIOPE passed tiring rivals. REEL VICTORY also passed faders. SHEHASHIGHOPES failed to menace. KIT KATS LUCK chased early, bid after five furlongs then flattened out. MS DILLER set a quick pace early then faded. FEISTY BROAD was through early.
