HAPPY BULL broke in a tangle then closed outside rivals and drew clear under pressure in the final furlong. POPPA'S PICK broke sharp to duel for the lead between rivals then was not good enough. SONG OF STARS, never far back, responded well in the drive between horses to gain the show. CABARET COWBOY trailed to the stretch then responded well in the drive. HOMECROFT matched strides racing three abreast then faded in final furlong. MISSISSIPPI MAN broke alertly to race in close pursuit then faded in the drive. THUNDER JACK duelled for the lead along the inside rail then weakened in the drive. SIR DUNCAN tired.
