VICAR'S TUNE unhurried early, made a three wide middle move to contention, bid for and gained a short lead a furlong out then prevailed late under pressure. FERBER also made a middle omve, bid from between rivals in the drive but was outkicked late. BAD BANDIT chased from the outset, also bid after six furlongs but was outfinished in the crucial stages. GALLOPING THUNDER rushed to the front early, set a moderate pace then just hung late. BLACK HAWK SOARING was well placed but failed to respond. STAGE ROMEO showed little. BANDJOLAIS trailed.
