SOUND CHECK broke alertly, set a slow pace under good rating then shook free and drew off late when roused. ECRU EGRET raced wide from the outset then was pushed farther out by PLEASANT BEAU when that one bobbled and ducked out in the second turn before rallying along the far outside to be up for the place late. SINGING ROCK stalked the pace early, bid three wide into the stretch then weakened under pressure. WARACHA split rivals leaving the second turn to challenge then gave way in the drive. TUCKLINO was well placed but failed to respond. LUCKMAN passed tiring rivals. WISE CHIEF was through after a half. DELTA MOON failed to menace. POR SUPUESTO pressed the pace three wide then faded. POLISH DYNAMITE was no factor. PLEASANT BEAU drove up in between rivals in the second turn, bobbled and was forced to take up then swerved out. I'MA A FAX stopped. There was a stewards inquiry conducted into the race before the results were declared official.
