ECONOMIC STIMULUS raced close up early, bid into the second turn then shook clear and drew off through the drive under brisk pressure. INDYS VALAY set a moderate pace early, was no match for the winner after seven furlongs but was easily second best. PLEASURE TO PLEASE was well placed outside the top two into the second turn but failed gain thereafter. DADDY'S KEELY hopped at the break. SENTEYA failed to menace. TURNER LOOSE stopped.
