MAX'S PAL chased the leader from the outset, bid leaving the turn then prevailed over DISCO RICO and STORMIN OEDY after a prolonged drive. DISCO RICO sprinted clear early, resisted well when challenged by the winner then hung late while saving the place. STORMIN OEDY made a four wide middle move then was slowly gaining late. Z COOL was boxed inside to the stretch, angled off the rail then failed to respond. B L'S APPEAL was through after a half. DONT TELL THE KIDS chased outside to the quarter pole then faded. LITTLEEXPECTATIONS turned in a dull effort. JEBSON had no speed, was angled wide after the start and trailed.
