FLIRT WITH DANGER bobbled slightly at the start then was well placed along the inside, moved closer on the far turn then came out for the drive and collared the leader a furlong out then drew off while being ridden out. BALLET PARTNER (GB), unhurried early, responded well in the drive to get up for second. HIGH POST saved ground setting the pace to midstretch, faded and was caught for second. RIZZI GIRL moved up menacingly outside rivals leaving the far turn then needed more in the drive. BLONDAWAY prompted the pace two wide and weakened in the drive. SAMANTHA THE GREAT saved ground and lacked a solid stretch response. MINER'S CLEMENTINE was outrun. Portable inner rail set at zero feet.
