SHETAN was unhurried early then moved up quickly into the far turn to gain the lead then was ridden out to draw off smartly. MOTOWN HUSTLE was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to get up for second. MACH TWELVE moved closer around the far turn then just missed for second. BOW TIE moved up around rivals on the far turn then finished well. SLEW CAT FEVER broke alertly to dispute the pace then faded in the drive. SASSY BEAN, well placed racing close up inside, lacked the needed rally. GLOBO DE ORO was unhurried early then was checked when blocked along the inside on the far turn. PIE TOWN prompted the pace then faded in the drive. GO FOR PORTER was checked in traffic leaving the far turn. IRON MYSTERY prompted

the pace then tired. DISTINCTIVE ALIBI disputed the pace for six furlongs then had little left. DUBIDUBIDU prompted the early pace then tired.
