D'COFFEE CAT dueled for six furlongs, shook clear from STEVE N ALEX into the stretch then pulled away when roused through the drive. STEVE N ALEX was in tight in the first turn, recovered to stalk the pace for five furlongs, tried unsuccessfully to collar the winner leaving the second turn but was no match for that one while best of the rest. SECRET SLIDE was well placed inside into the 4 furlong grounds but failed to gain late. CRITICAL STING passed tiring rivals. BEAU AMERICAN raced evenly. GIBSON CREEK came in during the run to the first turn, dueled for six furlongs then came up empty. CONTENDER was in tight and steadied into the first turn then stopped.
