Footnotes

LISETTE broke sharp to show the way and turned back the challenge of HONOUR WAVE in midstretch to win going away. HONOUR WAVE got in and crowded inside rivals into the first turn, was sent up outside the winner leaving the far turn and loomed boldly to midstretch then faded. GOVERNMENT BAILOUT moved closer around the far turn then flattened out in the drive. LADY WINAWAY was checked sharply on heels entering the first turn. SPANISH CRYSTAL was forced into the inside rail and was taken up sharply entering the first turn then prompted the early pace and tired. MYSTIC GOLD was checked out over heels into the first turn then was being eased in deep stretch. SOME clipped heels in tight quarters and unseated her rider into the first turn. Following a stewards inquiry into the run to the first turn, HONOUR WAVE was disqualified to seventh.
