GRANT PARK chased early, bid into the second turn to gain the lead then drew off when roused in the drive. QUANTOCK was void of early speed, angled out four wide then was up for the place. LOOKS LIKE SIS broke alertly, set a solid pace then weakened in the drive. COUNTESS JOHANNA lodged only a mild rally late. GROOM'S TRIAL stalked the pace for six furlongs three wide then faded. ATLANTIC TIDE was well placed but came up empty. DESERT BABY was no factor. POTNIA'S SONG showed little. LADY WOLF stalked the pace for six furlongs then stopped.
