SUFFOLK COUNTY set a moderate pace for a half, shook clear leaving the turn to mid stretch then was sharply roused to last late. YANKEE RIDGE pressed the issue from the outset, held on well when the winner drew clear in the furlong grounds then finished willingly to just miss. MR. COMMISSIONER fanned four wide after a half, loomed boldly outside rivals leaving the furlong grounds then was outfinished late. SCRIPT WRITER was void of speed for a half then closed a gap too late. TRICKY TRIPPI raced evenly. MISTER TEA was through after a half. HAT CITY failed to menace. FUTURES TRADER raced dully then pulled up in apparent distress and was vanned off. MONSTER BABY stumbled badly after the start unseating his jockey. There was a stewards inquiry conducted into the start before the results were declared official.
