STELLAR BRUSH, unhurried for a half, made a strong four wide move to contention through the second turn and into the stretch then ran down SMART GUY in the final sixteenth. The latter sprinted to the front into the first turn, set the pace under patient handling then just hung in deep stretch while clearly second best. SUCCESSFUL APPEAL made a three wide move passing the quarter pole but failed to sustain that rally. LYRACIST raced inside to the stretch, angled out but had no rally. DANCIN RAHY saved ground stalking the pace for six furlongs and gave way. WHO EZZE showed little. RAIRE STANDARD raced within striking distance for six furlongs and gave way. YANKEE VICTOR, chased the winner to the quarter pole and stopped.
