COURTING WISDOM vied for the lead outside, shook clear into the furlong grounds then slowly pulled away under pressure. GONE MISSING was in tight and forced to steadied inside the leaders approaching the turn, recovered to bid outside into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while saving the place. LIGER was unhurried early then lodged a belated bid through the final furlong. BOSS ZACH passed tiring rivals. JOHNS GROOMS was in tight and shuffled back inside approaching the turn. CASH MCCOOL dueled early, drifted in after a quarter then faded. TRICKY START was through after a half. There was a stewards inquiry conducted into the race before the result was declared official.
