CAROL'S JIMMY vied for the lead along the inside rail then was eased back before a half mile, moved to engage the leader again with a two wide bid with three furlongs remaining then won under a steady drive. KAY ONE broke sharp to dispute the pace and fought it out gamely to the end. TURBIN was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to close the gap late. DIVERSIFICATION lacked the needed rally. CLAWER failed to threaten. BROADWAY BLUES ducked out on the first turn then prompted the pace for six furlongs and tired.
