AZTEC RUN was away alertly then never far back and responded well in the drive. PIANO RED was unhurried early then closed outside rivals in the stretch. DEUCES TAKEM moved up menagingly on the far turn then lacked the needed closing bid. OUR DUET was blocked along the inside into and around the far turn then continued willingly in the. MISTY SURPRISE stumbled at the start. HUNDRED ADAMS vied for the lead racing two wide then faded in the drive. EIGHTEEN TWELVE moved up wide on the far turn then lacked a further response. POLISH DISCO saved ground disputing the pace then weakened in the drive. EL GATOR lacked a rally. JAMMAR prompted the pace then tired.
