TRI TO BE TRUE made a run into the stretch and responded well in the drive to finish second best. BRIGHTEST HOUR prompted the pace to the stretch then faded and held third. TRICKEY MICKEY failed to seriously menace. BRUSHED UP was not a threat. TAKIN INVENTORY showed little. QUILLO'S PRINCE tired. J. ALFRED PRUFROCK showed nothing. DIL saved ground setting the pace for a half mile and stopped. BIG SUR prompted the early pace and tired.
