FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$200 to enter and \$350 to start.

Supplemental nominations of \$800 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$55,000 Added, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three year olds, 117 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Non-Winners of \$30,000 on the turf since April 17 allowed 2 lbs.; \$24,000 twice on the turf in 2007, 4 lbs.; \$18,000 on the turf in 2007, 6 lbs.

(Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings on the turf in 2006-2007. Closed Tuesday, June 5th, 2007 with 21 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management notto run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs) (Rail at 25 feet).

TRULY BLUSHED broke sharp to set all the pace, drifted in a bit at the gap in midstretch then was under a hard drive to narrowly prevail. TOP TEN LIST raced close up then in traffic leaving the turn, angled to the rail for the final furlong and closed gamely to just miss. COLI BEAR, forwardly placed, gradually closed the gap in the final furlong. WILD BERRY, never far back, was going well late near the inside rail. KEEP ON TALKING was outrun to the stretch then responded well in the drive. DISCO DISCO JAN chased the winner to the stretch then weakened. RUNAWAY CAT showed early speed then weakened in the drive. Portable inner rail set at 25 feet.
