MOMMA'S HAPPY was unhurried early, looped four wide to challenge out of the second turn then dueled through a long drive and was all out to prevail. WILDLEE CERTAIN stalked the pace outside, bid three wide after five furlongs then dueled through a long drive before just missing in a game effort. MY LUCA was void of speed to the stretch then angled out five wide and closed a gap but too late. D'ORO DANCER passed tiring rivals. FRANCESCO PUNCH dueled to the stretch then gave way. SUTTON ROAD was well placed to the quarter pole then faded. GAMBINE ROAD chased early, bid in the second turn then came up empty.
