HUMBLE AND HUNGRY advanced along the inside into the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and drew clear then held rival safe. TAPIT EXPRESS moved closer leaving the far turn, drifted in in the final furlong and finished well. RELAY BILL saved ground disputing the pace then faded in the drive and saved third. GRIP HANDS hopped at the start then was well placed close to the pace and was steadied briefly in the stretch. BROXBOURNE was unhurried early then responded well in the drive. EVERSOU saved ground and made up some ground in the stretch. RIGHTEOUS PLACE lacked a solid rally. PARIS IS ART showed little. MR. ONLINE lacked a rally. JUST SAYIN moved closer on the far turn then flattened out in the drive. FLYING BIRD tired. UNBROKEN vied for the lead racing two wide then tired.
