MYSTIC MIRAGE saved ground vying for the early lead, drew clear into the stretch and was under a steady drive to prove best. NAUTICAL AGENT, unhurried early, made a run into the stretch and finished willingly. DREAMLINER was well placed close to the pace and lacked the needed stretch response. CLOWN FACTOR was pinched back at the start then continued well to best the rest. BAHAMA MISS vied for the lead outside the winner then weakened in the drive. SADLER'S CHARM lacked a rally. HOLLY'S PUNCH moved up menacingly on the far turn then flattened out in the drive. MOJAVE HUNTRESS was checked leaving the chute then taken up in traffic on the first turn. CALL MARTY was checked in tight quarters in the run leaving the chute. DARN THAT THUNDER's rider lost a stirrup in the run leaving the chute then couldn't be competitively ridden and dropped back steadily. A stewards inquiry was conducted into the run to and around the first turn. Portable inner rail set at 25 feet.
