Footnotes

BRUANNA dueled outside for five furlongs, shook off DIFFICULT DOLL and drew off late. IMPERIAL WAGER raced close up, was no match for the winner but outfinished the rest. DIFFICULT DOLL dueled inside to the furlong marker then weakened. GREELY'S DREAM was forwardly placed but failed to gain. HONEYMOON HARBOR raced evenly. TRICKSWORD failed to menace. LADY CORDELIA was not threatening when she was forced to jump the stricken horse leaving the turn. OZILDA'S KAREN jumped and grazed the fallen rider leaving the turn then was pulled up into the stretch. FAIR COUNT stalked the pace for a half then bobbled and fell leaving the turn, unseating his rider heavily. There was a stewards inquiry held into the incident before the race was declared official.
