HAPPY GABBY, never far back, responded willingly in the drive to close the gap. DIGGIN' THE GOLD was away alertly to be forwardly placed and responded well in the drive. DURAJAZZ was outrun early then rallied in the stretch. LITTLE RIGHT DOVE, forwardly placed, lacked the needed rally. MEXICAN RIVIERA duelled for the lead racing two wide and weakened in the drive. CHEER THE HEROES tired. Portable inner rail set at 25 feet.
