LADINA saved ground stalking the pace, swung out leaving the far turn to bid three wide for the lead in upper stretch then was ridden out. MORAVIA, unhurried early, made a run into the stretch and finished willingly for second. MEMORY OF MITCH, well placed close to the pace between rivals, was shuffled back at the top of the stretch then continued well. JEUX DE DANSE prompted the pace racing two abreast and weakened in the drive. MISS BEVERLY, forwardly placed outside rivals, flattened out in the drive. LA PROSPECT saved ground showing the way and had nothing left for the drive. MISSY'S ADVANTAGE showed little.
