GREAT KATE ABOVE, well placed close to the pace, finished gamely to hold on for third. ELIZAVETA responded well in the drive to be going well at the end. CHANGE THAT DIAL was unhurried early then rallied mildly. CRYSTAL DREAMS lacked a solid rally. HIGH REV BEV stalked the pace racing near the inside then weakened in the drive. ECHO TAP showed little. WANNA BE A COYOTE prompted the pace then tired. MAJOR ALLIE was taken up sharply along the inside entering the far turn then was pulled up.
