CUDJO settled after a half then lodged a mild rally inside. MR. COMMISSIONER was well placed to mid stretch then gave way. PLUTO broke sluggishly, was outrun for a half then was going well late from between rivals. BIOHAZZARD failed to menace. BOBBY SANDS chased for a half then faded. TIPSY SAINT was no factor. SNUCKINTHEFOREST was hung wide for a half then came up empty.
