MADDY'S RAVENS made a run on the far turn then was no match for the winner and saved second. PONCE INTO SPRING was forwardly placed and finished best of the others. ABOVE THE DRAMA was well placed close to the pace then flattened out in the drive. TREATY NOTICE failed to threaten. UNIVERSALIS made a run into the far turn then lacked a further response. MISTER FUNNYCAT showed little. WHO MATTERS showed the way for a half mile then tired. PROFIT MAKER tired. SASSY BEAN was eased in deep stretch.
