Footnotes

PICOU made a middle move through the second turn, angled outside for the drive then rallied past the leaders leaving the furlong marker to be along in time. BROTHER SY was never far back, bid three wide after five furlongs, gained a short lead in the drive but hung late while saving the place. NATIONBUILDER was void of early speed, angled outside for the drive then closed fast but was too late. HOUND set a slow pace then weakened late. WIZARD'S LAUGH chased early, bid after five furlongs then gave way in the final furlong. PULPIANO failed to menace. GIRON was no factor. TOUGH AS TEAK chased to the second turn then faded. COLONIAL CAUSEWAY stopped.
