EMMA SONG was well placed close to the pace, moved to the lead completing six furlongs then won under strong handling. MALIBU MURMUR edged closer on the far turn then responded well in the drive. NIGHTMARE NIGHT, never far back, finished well to get up for the show. EVENING STAR was unhurried early near the inside, swung wide for the drive and closed well. ELEGANT AFFAIR moved up around rivals leaving the far turn then continued well. ROYAL SEPTOR moved closer on the far turn then lacked the needed closing response. SO VERY HAPPY was forwardly placed to the far turn then faded in the drive. DIVINATION raced close up near the inside rail then weakened in the drive. OCEAN THUNDER lacked a rally. LADY ME LADY ducked out at the start, saved ground setting the pace to the far turn then tired.
