EVE GISELLE set the early pace removed from the inner rail, held on well when displaced on the lead into the stretch then came back on again inside in the furlong grounds and pulled away late. TAR HEEL MOM pressed the pace outside early, gained a short lead leaving the turn but weakened in the final furlong. WILDCAT ALY vied between rivals for a half then gave way in the drive. KID KATE showed little. INDIAN LEGEND failed to threaten.
