DUNLIN moved to the lead into the backstretch to set the pace to midstretch and gave way grudgingly. MATOI was unhurried early then finished well to run down rival for the show. HAZ THE BEAT broke alertly to be forwardly placed and was edged out late for third. ORITHYIA lacked a rally. ALASKAN DAWN showed little. SPANISH BLUES was outrun. GIGI'S SPEED tired from her early effort.
