**Footnotes**

BLACK IT OUT was eased back along the inside on the first turn to stalk the pace, moved up two wide to bid for the lead on the far turn then drew clear and was under pressure to prevail. BITTER BRIDE, unhurried ear, rallied between rivals in upper stretch and closed well. STAR CREEK stalked the early pace inside, drifted wide at the top of the stretch and closed gamely. TANWI SPRING, unhurried early, closed well while trying to lug in through the stretch. MODEL TEA, well placed within striking distance, lacked the needed rally. ARKAH moved to the lead in the run to the first turn, saved ground setting pace and weakened in the drive. RIGBY lacked a solid rally. HIGH ROYAL HONOR was outrun. FLIGHT CARD showed little. PAPIER MACHE, fractious in the gate, prompted the early pace and tired. Portable inner rail set out 15 feet.
