CRAFTY LUCK chased the early leader, bid after three furlongs to gain the lead out of the turn then slowly drew away under brisk handling. PUPIL broke behind her field, advanced steadily after a quarter and was best of the rest. ANOTHER EPISODE chased the leaders from the outset but weakened in the drive. COPA made an outside middle move through the turn, was bumped when SPRING KITTEN bore out in upper stretch then weakened. HALO'S SUGAR lodged a mild rally late. QUOIT QUICK was no factor. ARISTAR'S PROSPECT chased the leaders for a half then was bumped out of the turn and gave way. SPRING KITTEN chased inside then bore out into the stretch to bump rivals while tiring. CHRISTIE LILY was also off slow. LISTENING FR WINGS was through early. PRONGHORN set the pace to the quarter pole then stopped badly. VALASH was through early.
