SUNNY STRIKE, in tight early, stalked the pace for five furlongs, angled out three wide on the second turn then after a prolonged drive, prevailed over SISTER BERTIE. The latter pressed the pace from the outset, gained a slight lead before a half, continued gamely through a long drive and just hung late while clearly second best. COMPLETE NUMBER broke awkwardly then was bumped at the start, was void of speed to the stretch then made up some ground late outside. CLASSIC CONTENDER, well placed, had no rally. SCARLET TESS sprinted clear into the first turn, contested the pace to mid stretch then weakened. LITLEDRUMMERGIRL was no factor. MY was through early. RETAIL SALES went evenly. SHE'S A RASCAL bore out in both turns.
