CAROLUS MAGNUS circled horses leaving the turn then ran down the leader in deep stretch and edged clear late. SUNNY EXCHANGE was shuffled back at the start, moved up to give chase and finished gamely. EL GOLEM (ARG) was outrun to the stretch then responded well in the drive to gain third. NEVILL'S MISTAKE was off a step slowly, moved to the lead into the turn and drew clear then was not good enough. THREE PIECE lacked the needed stretch response. GO ANGEL GO chased from the outset then faded in the drive. TOUGH JODI broke sharp to dispute the pace then weakened in the drive. THE DUKE RULES tired. JUST A LION showed little.
